Human Rights Campaign's MLK Donation Drive and Day of Service

Taking place every third Monday in January, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service is the only federal holiday observed as a national day of service – a “day on, not a day off.” By transforming Dr. King’s life and teachings into community action, MLK Day of Service helps to meet national challenges by bringing together people, strengthening communities, and benefiting those who serve.

In 2019, Houston will once again host one of these regional events to benefit the homeless LGBTQ youth of Montrose Grace Place on January 21st at Kindred Church (2515 Waugh Dr). People can come drop off donations all day and/or stay to help sort and organize the donations. Needed items include: sleeping bags, small toiletries, and clothes (not red or blue) that would be good for youth ages 13-21. Neighbors can keep an eye out for donation drop off stations across the area, bring their items to the church on Jan. 21, or shop the Amazon wishlist at tinyurl.com/mgpwishlist.

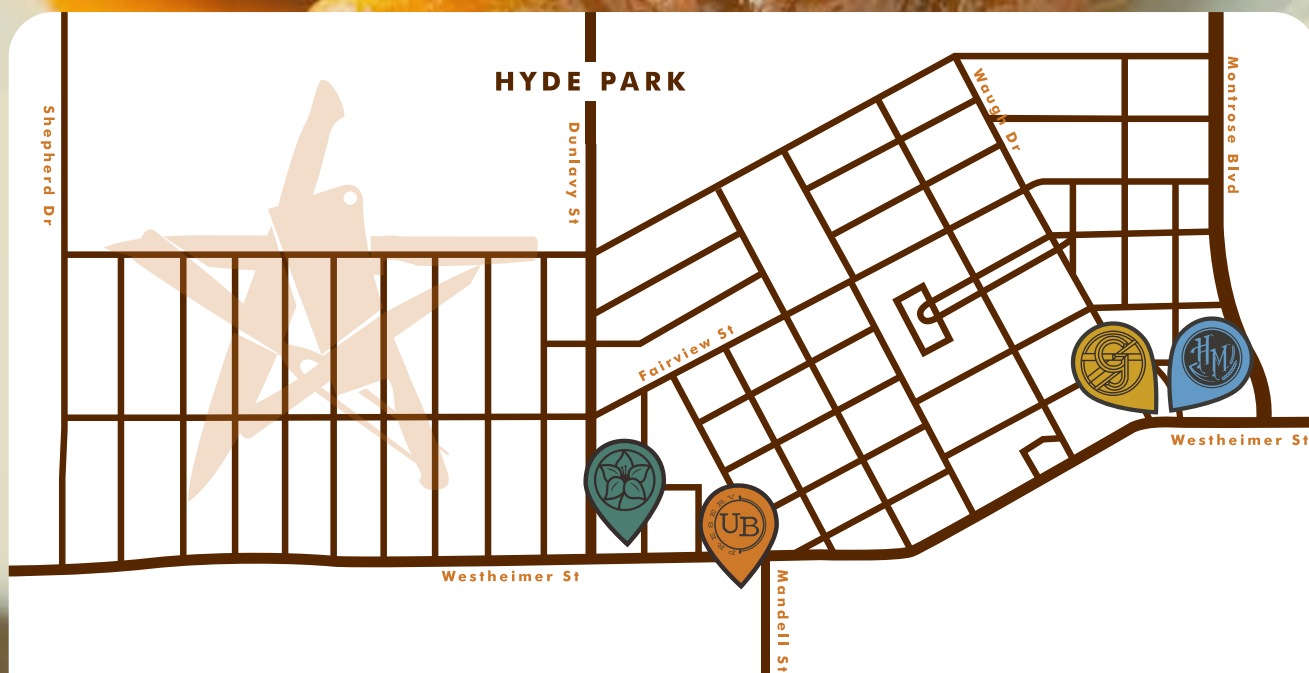

Support Local Theater While Listening to Great Music by Women Performers at Rudyard's

FEBRUARY 9, BEGINNING AT 6:00 PM

In 2018, Mildred's Umbrella (MU) decided to throw out the traditional gala format in favor of a benefit concert featuring local women artists, musicians, and women-centric service organizations. The resulting event was magical. Headlined by Houston punk legends Mydolls, with alt-rock power trio, Quinn the Brain, and synth-pop goddess, MIEARS supporting, the night was a huge success and raised nearly \$5,000 for the Houston theatre company dedicated to promoting works by women.

For the 2019 concert the ENTIRE venue at Rudyard's British Pub will be used for more musical acts, a dedicated silent auction area and vendor space, plus a VIP area. Music groups will include: MIEARS, Pretty Vacant, Quinn the Brain, Marina Rocks, Evelyn Rubio, Sweet Mama Cotton, Benita, Lazer Kittenz, Alli Villines, and more.

This year local women-owned small businesses like Christi Chaos's Goth Yoga and service organizations like Houston Area Women's Center, Planned Parenthood, and United Against Human Trafficking will provide information and volunteer opportunities.

Mildred's Umbrella is the only theatre in Houston dedicated to supporting and promoting the work of women in the performing arts. They do this because they believe representation matters. For too long, women's stories have been silenced, women's issues have been made a political hot potato, and women's rights have been denied. Play by play, story by story, hire by hire, they are working to celebrate women's stories, challenge the status quo, and find the beauty and delight in an often-dirty world.

The silent auction will include gift cards from area businesses like Underbelly Hospitality and others.

Sponsorships begin at \$500, individual tickets range from \$10 to \$50 (some include drinks and food). Tickets can be purchased on their web site: www.mildredsumbrella.com or you can call 832-463-0409 for more information.

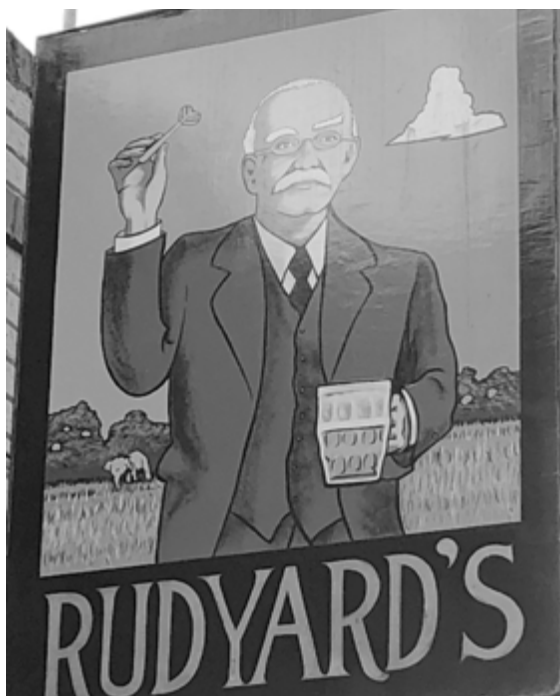
Hyde Park Civic Association – 2019 Monthly Meeting Schedule
